

WELLOW AND DISTRICT DOG TRAINING CLUB

PROGRESSION SCHEME

1.	Successfully jumping three fences in a row followed by going through an expandable tunnel.	1 tier rosette
2.	Successfully going up and down the A frame, at full height, ensuring that good contact is made on <u>ALL</u> contact points.	1 tier rosette
3.	Successfully going up, along and down the Dog Walk, at full height, ensuring that good contact is made on <u>ALL</u> contact points.	1 tier rosette
4.	Successfully negotiating a line of 12 weave poles – ensuring a correct entry (ie. Left shoulder to the first weave pole) and that all poles are weaved through and in the correct order.	1 tier rosette
5.	Successfully jumping through the tyre, followed by negotiating the flat tunnel (without someone having to hold one end up)	1 tier rosette
6.	Having successfully obtained stages 1 to 5 above, being able to demonstrate a correct and competent use of the see-saw ensuring that good contact is made on <u>ALL</u> contact points, and that each end of the see-saw touches the ground safely during the exercise.	5 tier Rosette

RULES:

- All of the above schemes must be undertaken off the lead, with the owner able to demonstrate control of their dog at all times.
- Any new dog must have attended at least 4 training sessions prior to starting this progression scheme.
- Whilst stages 2 to 5 (inclusive) may be taken in any order, stage 1 must be undertaken first, and stage 6 may not be attempted until stages 1 to 5 inclusive have been achieved.
